Start Time:

All Men's Leagues are 6 PM **shotgun** starts. As a member of Men's League, you can play 9 holes prior to the 6 PM League at no additional cost! Just be sure to schedule your tee time with the Pro Shop.

Nightly Spares:

Members \$10 **Non Members \$25**
Those looking to spare need to call or email the Monday of the day that they are looking to play. Spares also have the option to play nine holes prior to the shotgun start.

Tees:

A, B, C & D Players under 60 years of age = blue tees
A, B, C & D Players 60 & Over = blue or white tees
If playing from the white tees, the player must adjust the strokes given by one. For example, if Player A is playing from the Blue tees and Player B, who is 60 or over and play from the white tees and both players are 20 handicaps, then Player B would give Player A one stroke on the nine they are playing – adjusted by one stroke.

Gold Key Insurance
- Toonie Putt:

Eight years strong, we are excited to welcome back Gold Key Insurance – Julia, Jayson & Kingsley as our title sponsor for the nightly Toonie Putt! Starting April 9th and going until the Wind Up August 27th, each night after golf we will draw two names from the list of nightly sign ups for their chance of making a 30ft putt inside the clubhouse. The money collected each night carries over until someone makes the putt. And remember, house rules, the ball has to stay in the cup to count!

Check In Procedures:

Upon arrival there are **TWO** things that you **MUST** do: 1) Highlight your name on your team list in the boardroom & 2) Sign in for any additional contests at the Pro Shop. By highlighting your name you help the Pro Shop staff identify which teams require spares. If your name is not highlighted, you are considered to be absent and will not be entered into nightly draw prizes. You must be present to win a draw prize.

Spares:

There are EIGHT spots on a permanent spare list. Players can pay the regular sign up fee and will fill-in on a team where a spare is needed each night. Permanent spares will play each week, however, they will be on a different team each night.

In addition, each week we will need nightly spares to fill in for those players not present. Like Men's League Members, spares can play an additional nine holes prior to the 6 PM League. The cost for nightly spares is \$10 for members and \$25 for non members. Those who are interested in sparing are asked to contact the Pro Shop the Monday morning of, to have their name added to the spare list. (403) 934 2299 Ext 1

Points: Each **individual** match is worth 2 points for a outright win, 1 point for a tie and 0 for a loss. The total amount of points each night is 16 from all eight team matches. For the scramble, the following point system will be used (for each nine): 1st = 8 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th – 6th = 2 Points and 7th – 8th = 1 points. If there is a tie for the scramble, then the tying teams will each receive full points. For example if Team A and B finish tied for 1st then each team will receive 8 points.

Playoffs: 2018 men's playoffs will run Aug 20th & Aug 27th, and are worth double points! 4 Points for a Individual win, 2 Points for a Individual tie, and 0 points for a Individual loss. In the playoffs the number 1 seed team will play the number 8 seed team and so on. After the Aug 20th the standings will be updated and the same process will be in place for the wind up men's night on Aug 27th.

Proximities: Winning a proximity prize will **NOT** help Team Standings. Each proximity prize that is won, will be worth 0.5 points for your Individual standing! This excludes any draw prizes (nightly draw prizes, ball in water draw)

Teams: Each team consists of eight players, of which are broken down into two players for each group.

Groups: Players are divided into four groups – A's, B's, C's & D's. This is done once 112 or 128 spots are filled.

Handicaps: Staff will monitor handicaps every week which means you must enter your score every week. **Be sure to obtain your Member ID # to access the computerized handicap system.** Posted handicaps are to be used each night. When applying a players handicap, the following is to be used: If Player A's HDCP is 10 & B's is 7, the difference is 3. Therefore B would give Player A two strokes if playing the front nine & one stroke if playing the back nine. The front nine is the higher of the HDCP split.

ALL PLAYERS MUST ENTER THEIR 9 HOLE SCORES EACH WEEK IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR NIGHTLY SKINS. IF A PLAYER DOES NOT ENTER THEIR SCORE FROM THE WEEK PRIOR, THEY CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN SKINS AND THEIR ENTRY FEE WILL BE PAID OUT.

Format: Match Play Format is used each night, with the first night being a scramble. HDCP's are used for Match Play, but not for the scramble. If a player does not show up and no spare is assigned then the remaining player will play against both players from the opposing team, Ex. 2. If both players from the same team & group do not show up, then the remaining two players will play against one player from each of the groups from the opposing team, Ex. 3. If there is only one player present from a team, the single player will play against all four opposing players as a five-some. For the below scenarios, 8 points are always played for.
