

## Strathmore Golf Club Memorial Program

The Strathmore Golf Club has developed a Memorial Tree / Bench Program that will allow groups or individuals to donate money towards trees or benches to commemorate special events or loved ones who have passed.

The following outlines each item that is available and donations can be made in full or partially. The cost per bench or tree is \$500 and this is a one time fee, which includes a plaque to include a written message of the donor's choice. To donate your own tree (from your property) to the golf course, the donor is responsible for all handling/transporting fees and a \$40 fee; which will cover the price of the plaque.

### Strathmore Golf Club Memorial Trees

All selection of trees has been carefully selected to ensure their best chance of survival. Soil analysis has helped to determine the species of tree that is best suited for the soil conditions along the right side of number 9 – where all memorial trees will be planted (starting from the clubhouse patio back to the gold tee). The Golf Club will decide exactly where the tree(s) are to be planted.

Memorial trees along hole 9 will have appropriate tree wells filled with bark mulch. Rocks with attached plaque placed inside of tree wells will be no larger than a basketball. Those who purchase the tree(s) are responsible for any flowers, flower care or other type of planting inside the tree well.

The Turf Department will care for the memorial tree: providing the tree with water, fertilizer and keeping the tree well free of weeds.

### Strathmore Golf Club Memorial Trees Types



#### 1. Russian Olive *Elaeagnus angustifolia*

A small tree with a dense crown of attractive silver-grey foliage. Subtle yellow flowers with an overwhelming fragrance in spring; followed by small edible silver berries in summer. Mature tree spread is approximately 5m tall and 4m in diameter.





## 2. Snowbird Hawthorn *Crataegus mordenensis*

Dark green, glossy leaves with double white flowers in late spring followed by bright crimson berries in fall. Mature tree spread is approximately 5m tall and 4m in diameter.

## 3. White Spruce *Picea glauca*

Dense evergreen with a strong central leader and a distinctive pyramidal form. Green needles emerge light green in spring and are shorter and softer than Colorado Spruce. Mature tree spread is 20m tall and 4m in diameter.



## 4. Baron Manitoba Maple *Acer negundo* 'Baron'

Fast growing male selection. A hardy native tree tolerant of drought and a variety of soil conditions. Green foliage turns yellow in fall. Mature tree spread is 12m tall and 10m in diameter.

## 5. Brandon Elm *Ulmus americana* 'Brandon'

Cultivar of American Elm with a more compact, vase-shaped canopy. Nice dark green, serrated leaves turn a nice gold colour in fall. Mature tree spread is 15m tall and 10m in diameter.



## 6. Trembling Aspen *Populus tremuloides*

Slender graceful native tree. Small, round-shaped, green leaves that flicker in the wind and turn an attractive yellow fall colour. Mature tree spread is 10m tall and 5m in diameter.

## Strathmore Golf Club Memorial Benches

Made of durable recycled plastic, these six foot long benches, will be placed on the golf course at locations approved by the General Manger and Superintendent. Plaques with a message chosen by the donor will be placed on the backrest of the bench.
